

### A Child's Perspective: What to expect at your appointment?

We are all very excited about working with you at BALL@UT. You will meet our research team at your first appointment. We are interested in how children learn and remember information. We are also interested in learning about movement and performance on our learning games. With your permission, we will ask you to complete learning games, watch movie clips, and answer questions about how you feel.



We will ask you to wear “special watches” while you play the learning games. The watches are placed on your hand and ankles. Please let us know if they become uncomfortable at any time.



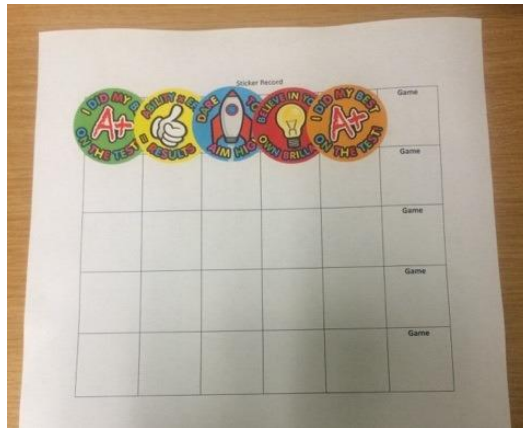
We will tell you how to play each learning game. You may ask us questions if you do not understand how to play the learning games. Please let us know if you want to skip a question or stop playing the game at any time.



While you play learning games, members of the research team will meet with your guardian/parent(s) to review paperwork and ask questions about your family history.



Each session will take about 2 hours to complete. You will earn a sticker for completing each learning game.



You will have many breaks to watch short movie clips, eat a snack, have a drink of water, and play video games.



At the end of your visit, you may select a prize from our prize box.
